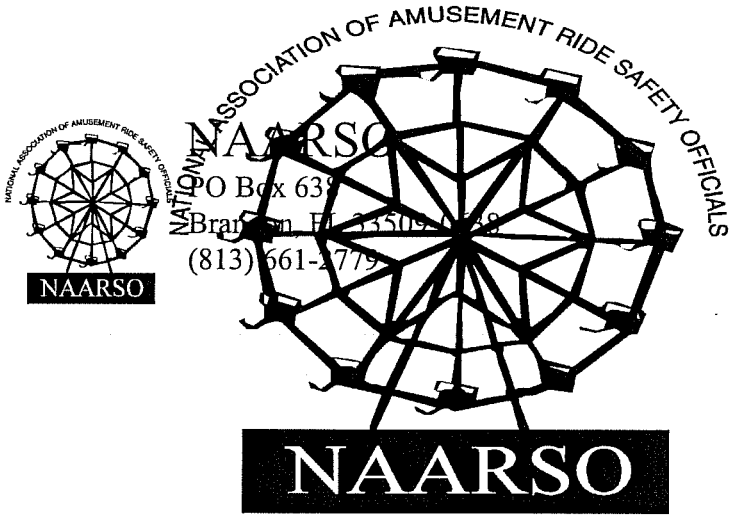

GOALS

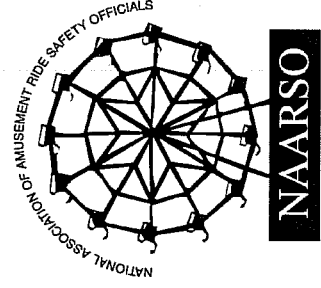
NAARSO was developed specifically to serve the needs of government agencies and their employees involved in amusement ride safety. Its goals are as follows:

- To provide a forum for the discussion of questions related to amusement ride safety, administration, regulation, and enforcement at all levels of city, county, state, provincial and federal government of the United States and Canada.
- To provide a mechanism to establish policy and coordinate activities within the Association of national and international significance.
- To promote a consensus on model laws, regulations, standard codes, enforcement, and administrative procedures among jurisdictions.
- To foster cooperation among regulatory officials themselves and between them and all of the many manufacturing, industrial, business, and consumer interests affected by their official activities.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership in NAARSO shall be open to those involved in or concerned with amusement ride safety and shall consist of two classes of membership: **Active** and **Associate**.

- **Active** membership is limited to amusement ride safety officials and jurisdictional agencies actively engaged in regulatory service and in the employ of an agency of the Federal Government, Municipalities, States, Commonwealths, Territories, Provinces or Possessions of the United States and Canada, or the District of Columbia. **Active** members may include those commissioned by, contracted by or authorized by any of the agencies having amusement ride safety jurisdiction. Also with the Board of Directors approval, **Active** membership is available to individuals whose primary responsibility is amusement ride safety.
- **Associate** membership is open to representatives of manufacturers, industry, business, consumers, and other persons or organizations who are interested in the objectives and activities of the Association. **Associate** members have the privilege of the floor at all meetings of the Association and have voting privileges at committee and task force levels.
